- I. Title I Description**
  - a. Federally Funded Grant -ESSA**
  - b. Largest federal assistance program for schools**
    - i. CCSD budget is approximately 4.5 million**
    - ii. 85% spent on salaries (teachers, AF, PEF, tutors for N and D)**
    - iii. Additional funds for parent engagement, equipment, supplemental materials, PD**
    - iv. Supplements what the district already gives**
    - v. Serves ages 5-17**
  - c. Supplemental services for all subject areas school (target most at-risk subject areas)**
  - d. Purpose to support schools to ensure that all children have an opportunity to obtain a high-quality education and to achieve proficiency on high academic standards**
  - e. Title I Schools: Clark Creek, Hasty, Oak Grove, RM Moore, and Teasley**
- II. Title I Guidelines**
  - a. Schools qualify for Title I based on poverty-free and reduced lunch**
  - b. In CCSD we serve schools with a free and reduced lunch percentage greater or equal to 44%**
  - c. CES poverty level is currently 45% and qualifies for a Targeted Assistance Program for the first year**
  - d. CES must conduct a Needs Assessment to develop goals and strategies to meet the needs of the most at-risk students (school qualifies on poverty, but funds are used to support the lowest achieving students)**
  - e. The school will develop a TA Plan that will target the most at-risk students and the funds will be allocated to support those students specifically (including parent engagement activities and professional development for specific teachers)**



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- f. Throughout the year CES will work on developing a Schoolwide Plan to be implanted in 2020-2021
