AP Exam Registration Now Open!

Please find attached important information regarding AP Exam registration for exams to be administered May 3-14, 2021. The registration window opens Friday, August 21st and runs through October 23rd for semester 1 classes and yearlong courses. There will be a separate AP Exam registration window for semester 2 AP classes opening in January.

Students must first register for their exam by logging into www.myap.collegeboard.org account and enroll in their AP Class sections using the unique join code for each course provided to them by their teacher. Then, be sure to complete registration by visiting www.totalregistration.net/AP/110591 to register and pay for the exam. If you are taking a STEM exam, please make sure you check the STEM box so the waiver may be applied. To complete registration, students must answer all the indicated required questions. Registration is not complete until students print the confirmation page. Please see the attachment for more information. Fall Sport Attendance Guidelines

Due to Department of Health Guidelines, we will only be able to fill our venues to 25% capacity this season. ***All tickets must be purchased through GoFan*** when available. Social distancing guidelines will be strictly enforced, and it is highly encouraged that masks be worn.

Capacity limits for Creekview's venues this fall are as follows:

Football – Stadium capacity 1264: More information will be released the week of August 17th to football, band and cheer parents. Remaining tickets (if any) will be made available on the day of the event.

Volleyball – Gym capacity 272: Tickets will be sold on the day of the event.

Softball Complex – capacity 75: We will set aside 55 tickets for immediate family. The remaining 20 tickets will be made available to the opposing team.

In the event of a JV/Varsity doubleheader, we will clear the stands between games and allow families from both teams the opportunity to attend their student athlete’s game.

PUBLICATION OF DIRECTORY INFORMATION REGARDING YOUR STUDENT

The Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA), a Federal law, requires that CCSD with certain exceptions, obtain your written consent prior to the disclosure of personally identifiable information from your child's education records. However, CCSD may disclose appropriately

designated "directory information" without written consent, unless you have advised the CCSD to the contrary. If a parent/guardian objects to his/her child being included in any or all of the below, he/she must annually notify the Principal in writing by September 1st, or within one week of admission/enrollment if enrollment occurs after September 1st.

The primary purpose of directory information is to allow CCSD to include information from your child's education records in certain school publications and events. Examples include:

- A playbill, showing your student's role in a drama production;
- The annual yearbook;
- Honor roll or other recognition lists;
- Graduation programs;
- Recognition of achievement at School Board meetings;
- School District and School Websites;
- School and School District Social Media; and
- Sports activity sheets, such as for wrestling, showing weight and height of team members.

Directory information, which is information that is generally not considered harmful or an invasion of privacy if released, can also be disclosed to outside organizations without a parent's prior written consent. Outside organizations include, but are not limited to, companies that manufacture class rings, companies that publish yearbooks, military recruiters, college recruiters, law enforcement agencies, and the news media.

Directory information includes:

- Student's name
- Address
- Telephone listing
- Electronic mail address
- Photograph
- Date and place of birth
- Major field of study
- Dates of attendance
- Grade level
- Participation in officially recognized activities and sports
- Weight and height of members of athletic teams
- Degrees, honors, and awards received
- The most recent educational agency or institution attended
- Student ID number, user ID, or other unique personal identifier used to communicate in electronic systems but only if the identifier cannot be used to gain access to education records except when used in conjunction with one or more factors that authenticate the user's identity, such as a PIN, password, or other factor known or possessed only by the authorized user.
- A student ID number or other unique personal identifier that is displayed on a student ID badge, but only if the identifier cannot be used to gain access to education records except when used in conjunction with one or more factors that authenticate the user's identity, such as a PIN, password, or other factor known or possessed only by the authorized user.

IMPORTANT AP REGISTRATION INFORMATION

Creekview High School will be administering AP Exams **May 3-14, 2021** during the school day at an off campus location (please note the calendar below). **College Board has made some changes to their exam registration process. Important steps are listed below for your convenience:**

- ❖ **Registering for an exam is a two step process:**
 1. **Students will register for their exam(s) on myap.collegeboard.org**
 2. **They will register to pay for the exam(s) on the Total Registration website www.TotalRegistration.net/AP/110591**
- ❖ Students will sign in to myap.collegeboard.org and enroll in their AP class sections using the unique join code for each course provided to them by their teacher as soon as possible.
- ❖ **Students enrolled in AP Courses through GAVS will choose EXAM ONLY on myap.collegeboard.org and Total Registration.**
- ❖ Registration for exam payment on Total Registration will begin on Friday, August 21st and end on Friday, October 23rd for semester 1 and yearlong courses. Registration after this date will require a conversation with the AP coordinator as the registration window will be closed.
- ❖ Beginning November 12th, a \$40 late fee **per exam** will apply for semester 1 and yearlong courses.
- ❖ Registration for 2nd semester will begin on Total Registration on Friday, January 8th and end on Monday, March 1st. Beginning March 11th, a \$40 late fee per exam will apply for semester 2 courses.
- ❖ The 2021 AP exam fee is \$100.00.
- ❖ Creekview High School will only orders exams for students who have registered on myap.collegeboard.org and completed payment on Total Registration by the due date. There will be no extra exams available on test day.
- ❖ **The State of Georgia will pay \$86 per AP Exam for one AP Stem exam for students enrolled in AP STEM courses.**
- ❖ Only students approved for the Federal Free/Reduced Student Lunch program should click the button for AP Exam Reduced Registration Fee. Students currently participating

in the Federal Free/Reduced Lunch program qualify for a free exam and fee reduction

****If two or more of your exams conflict, register for both exams and Mrs. Whitley will order one exam for the regular administration and the other for the late administration.***

Morning exams begin at 8:00 AM and afternoon exams begin at 12:00 PM. **Students must arrive 30 minutes before the exam start time (7:30 AM for morning exams, and 11:30 AM for afternoon exams).** Sign-in/test security procedures and test directions will be completed in those 30 minutes. **Students late to the exam will not be allowed to test.**

*Students will not be able to access electronic equipment (such as cell phones, smart phones, smartwatches or other wearable technology including devices that can access the internet) and bags including but not limited to bookbags during testing and breaks. If a student is observed with any electronic devices during testing or breaks, the student may be dismissed from the exam room and the device may be confiscated. *Students should only bring several sharpened #2 pencils and pens with blue or black ink only. Other items allowed for specific tests will be communicated by the AP teacher.
