School Mission Statement

Free Home Elementary School is committed to increasing the social and academic achievements for every child.

School Improvement Goal 1

Starting with the 2017-2018 school year, Third through Fifth grade students will increase in ELA achievement from the baseline of 52% of students who score as Proficient and Distinguished Learners (Level 3 and 4) to 60% by May of 2021 as measured on the GA ELA Milestones Assessment.

School Improvement Year 1 Action Plan

- Implement **Student Centered Goal Setting** based on teacher feedback and assessments.
- Utilize **Response to Intervention** process with Tier 2 and Tier 3, specifically implementing reading strategies to increase student Lexile levels.
- Implement **Professional Learning Communities**.

School Improvement Goal 2

Starting with the 2017-2018 school year, Third through Fifth grade students will increase in Math achievement from the baseline of 55% of students who score as Proficient and Distinguished Learners (Level 3 and 4) to 65% by May 2021.

School Improvement Year 1 Action Plan

- Engage **Professional Learning Community** discussions around strategies focused on the i-Ready Diagnostic data.
- Implement **Student Centered Goal Setting** based on teacher feedback and assessments.
- Utilize **Response to Intervention** to implement math strategies that increase student achievement.
