

Guidance for Close Contacts:

Those identified as a close contact to a positive person (within 6 ft for a total of 15 minutes) will need to quarantine.

To ensure a healthy return to school within the 14-day quarantine time period there are 3 options for quarantine.

Option #1: Earliest return date: _____

- Complete a 7-day quarantine (with return on the 8th day)
- Provide a copy of a negative COVID-19 test collected **after** the 5th day of exposure. (Earliest date to test: _____)
- Remains without symptoms
- Wears a mask in school through day 14 of the initial exposure date
- Monitors symptoms at home through day 14 of the initial exposure date

Option #2: Earliest return date: _____

- Complete a 10-day quarantine (with return to regular activities on the 11th day)
- Remains without symptoms
- Wears a mask in school through day 14 of the initial exposure date
- Monitors symptoms at home through day 14 of the initial exposure date

Option #3: Earliest return date: _____

- Complete a 14-day quarantine (with return regular activities on the 15th day)
- Remains without symptoms

***If anyone who is a close contact becomes symptomatic or has a positive test during the 14 days following exposure, their guidance will change.**
