The Office of Capital Improvements (OCI) staff has reviewed the architect's monthly status report on the current construction projects. A summary of the progress for each project is shown below:

**Etowah HS Athletic Facility Improvements**

- This project is complete.

**Woodstock HS Auxiliary Gym**

- This project is complete.

The preliminary design for the Cherokee HS replacement facility was recently approved and OCI staff subsequently authorized the architect to submit the same to the GaDOE for its review and approval.

OCI staff continue with the planning and programming phases of the Free Home ES replacement facility, the classroom additions at Creekland MS and Creekview HS along with the auxiliary gym, and construction of the replacement bus washes at both Bus Shops I and II. Programming and schematic designs for each of these projects will be forthcoming.

A review of current space allocations for the proposed construction of a test kitchen for School Nutrition and a modernization of the Family and Consumer Science Lab at Sequoyah HS was recently conducted. The planning and programming of these designs will begin in mid to late February.
