Executive Summary



School Mission Statement

Cherokee High School strives to meet the social, emotional, and cognitive needs of all students to prepare them to become productive members of an ever-changing and diverse society.

School Improvement Goal 1

Starting in the 2022-2023 school year, CHS will increase achievement for all students in core academic areas (English, Math, Science and Social Studies) by 3 percentile points for each year (2022-2023, 2023-2024 and 2024-2025) as measured by the overall CCRPI Content Mastery score.

School Improvement Action Plan

- Develop **Student-Centered, Active-Learning Environments** focusing on **Instructional Clarity** through the use of **Active Learning Lesson Guides**.
- Implement the use of **Student-Centered, High-Impact Strategies** including **Classroom Discussion, Peer Feedback** and **Collaborative Learning**.
- Utilize **Progress Monitoring and Feedback** via data collection to develop assessment capable learners who can articulate the **Learning Targets and Success Criteria** of a lesson.

School Improvement Goal 2

Starting in the 2022-2023 school year, CHS will increase the overall Four-Year Graduation Rate by 1% (from 84.2% in 2021-2022) by increasing the number of students who are on-track providing supports to targeted subgroups.

School Improvement Action Plan

- Monitor student progress toward **Pathway Completion** (i.e. four-year graduation plans).
- Develop students' **Career and Future Readiness** by developing an understanding of student aptitudes, interests, and pathways to various future outcomes.
- Develop a **Sense of Individual and Community Leadership** which reinvigorates Warrior culture.
