Description and Policies

Team Mission

The mission of the Creekland Aeronautics Team is to introduce students to engineering concepts and the dynamics of flight.

Activities

Team members will participate in designing, building, and flying model rockets and compete in the Team America Rocketry Challenge (TARC). Members will be introduced to High Powered Rocketry and may choose to pursue their HPR Certification at their own expense.

National Organizations

Students joining the Aeronautics Team are encouraged, but not required, to join the National Association of Rocketry (NAR).

Attendance and Participation

Member participation is vital to the success of the team. Members must be able to attend meetings on a regular basis, meet for launches and special events and participate in team fundraising. Members with excessive absences, lack of participation, or poor sportsmanship will be removed from the team.

Launches

Team members are expected to attend launches. Launches typically take place on Sunday afternoons at Creekview HS, GMA field in Ball Ground, Veterans Park or other locale.

Minimum GPA

Team members are expected to maintain a minimum academic GPA of 3.0. Failure to do so will result in being dropped from the team. Team members are encouraged to seek help from their teachers at the first sign they may be struggling in a course. Student GPA will be checked at the end of each semester.
