



2019 SUMMER SCHOOL FOR RISING NINTH GRADERS
TAKING HIGH SCHOOL CREDIT COURSES (Personal Fitness and/or Health)

DATES: Wednesday, June 5, 2019 – Tuesday, June 25, 2019

TIMES: First Period: 8:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m.
Break: 12:00 p.m. – 12:30 p.m.

Rising ninth graders may elect to take .5 unit of Personal Fitness and/or .5 unit of Health for high school credit.

LOCATIONS: Cherokee HS for Rising Gr. 9 students at Cherokee HS, Creekview HS and Sequoyah HS

Etowah HS for Rising Gr. 9 students at Etowah HS, River Ridge HS and Woodstock HS

COST: \$200 per .5 Credit*

GENERAL INFORMATION:

Rising ninth graders are provided the opportunity to "March Ahead" by taking Personal Fitness and/or Health for High School credit in Summer School. High school students still needing to take these courses are also eligible to register though the high school. Courses will be offered to Cherokee County students when there is sufficient demand, and courses will be offered at Cherokee High School and Etowah High School. There must be an adequate number of students registered for a course before it will be offered at either or both Summer School locations (Cherokee HS and Etowah HS). When an inadequate number of students are registered for a specific course at both locations, efforts will be made to merge the students into one course and the course will be housed at the campus where the majority of the students registered for the course. Students will be notified by the Summer School Administrator if there are an inadequate number of students registered to offer a course or if students need to be merged to form a course on one campus. Each class is worth .5 unit of credit. A student may earn a maximum of 1 unit academic credit during the 15 days/60 hours summer school session (2 courses of .5 credit each).

TUITION: \$200.00 per .5 unit of credit*. All fees must be paid in full at the time of registration. Cash, Credit Card or Money Order are the only accepted methods of payment. Registration ends on the first day of summer school. Additional charges may be assessed for textbook/library book loss or damage. The book damage fee will follow the regular formula.

REFUNDS: Summer School is only 15 days with a rigorous curriculum. Be sure this is the appropriate forum for your child's success. NO REFUNDS WILL BE ISSUED ONCE CLASSES BEGIN. Those requesting a refund must complete a Refund Request form (located on the Cherokee County School District website under "Parent and Community" then "Forms" at <http://cherokeek12.net/forms/>) and submit to the Summer School Administrator. All refunds will be mailed the last week of June to the address listed on the Refund Request form.

ATTENDANCE: Students are expected to attend all classes. Upon the FIRST absence, students will be automatically dropped from class and receive a "W" on their transcript. THERE ARE NO EXCEPTIONS. IF A STUDENT PLANS TO BE ABSENT FOR ANY REASON SUCH AS CHURCH CAMPS, SPORTS CAMPS, VACATIONS, WEDDINGS, ETC., DO NOT REGISTER FOR SUMMER SCHOOL.

TRANSPORTATION: Transportation is not provided.

RULES: All Cherokee County School District rules and regulations including dress code will apply during Summer School. Any student in violation of the dress code will be sent home and counted as absent. Every student has received a copy of the Student/Parent Handbook at their home school which includes the Cherokee County Student Offense and Discipline Procedures. VIOLATIONS OF RULES WHICH REQUIRE SUSPENSION DURING THE REGULAR SCHOOL YEAR WILL BE GROUNDS FOR SUMMER SCHOOL DISMISSAL AND MAY CONTINUE INTO THE 2019-20 SCHOOL YEAR.

PICK UP POLICY: All students must be picked up no later than 12:00 p.m. for morning class or 4:30 p.m. for afternoon class. FAILURE TO ABIDE BY THIS RULE TWO TIMES WILL RESULT IN DISMISSAL FROM SUMMER SCHOOL AND NO REFUND OF TUITION WILL BE GIVEN. If this presents a problem, DO NOT REGISTER FOR SUMMER SCHOOL.

MEDIA COVERAGE: Summer School events and programs may be considered newsworthy and of interest to local communities. Your child may on occasion be interviewed or photographed by the news media for positive school news coverage. Your child's image, name or intellectual property may be included in School District publications or school web pages and through social media. If you do not approve of your child being included in any or all of the above media coverage, please make a note in the comment box on the registration form.

NON-CCSD STUDENTS: *Non-CCSD students who are residents of Cherokee County are allowed to participate in the School District's HS Summer School Program as long as (a) they can pay the established Non-CCSD student fee of \$300 per class for the coursework and (b) their participation does not displace CCSD students from the course. This has been extended (by prior approval) many times to students who may not reside in the county during the school year, but are visiting tax-paying parents/guardians for the summer. The same opportunity for Summer School participation does not exist for Title I, Bridge or ESY students because student fees are not accessed for the programs in which those students participate. Those programs are established from "same-year" funding derived and allocated based on students enrolled in the School District during the given year.
