Summary Explanation and Background
<p>Loretta Muise of Woodstock High School has been named the Georgia Council of Teachers of Mathematics' High School Teacher of Excellence for 2019!</p> <p>The Council presents three awards - one each for elementary, middle, and high school levels - annually are given to "excellent teachers who have strong content foundations in mathematics appropriate for their teaching level, show evidence of growth in the teaching of mathematics, and show evidence of professional involvement."</p> <p>Ms. Muise, who has 29 years of experience, is the school's math department chair and teaches Advanced Placement (AP) Calculus AB/BC and Multivariable Calculus. She joined CCSD as a math teacher at Woodstock HS in 2004 and was named the department chair in 2011 and the school's Teacher of the Year in 2015. Ms. Muise earned her bachelor's and master's degrees in mathematics from Salem State University and a specialist degree in education from Piedmont College.</p> <p>The Council praised Ms. Muise for demonstrating excellence in her profession: "Loretta is not only great at collaborating, she is a superb leader."</p>
