Summary Explanation and Background
<p>Etowah HS has earned national recognition for its successful efforts to raise student achievement!</p> <p>The school, led by Principal Robert Horn, has earned the Model Professional Learning Community at Work honor from Solution Tree, one of only 200 schools and districts in the nation - and the only school in Georgia -- to do so.</p> <p>CCSD uses the Professional Learning Communities (PLC) model in all of its schools to encourage collaboration, the sharing of data and best practices, and professional development among teachers, who are grouped by subject area and/or grade level of instruction.</p> <p>Solution Tree, a top provider of educational strategies and tools, selects honorees using criteria including evidence a school has effectively used these practices for at least three years and that those efforts have resulted in improved teaching and learning.</p>
