<p>For the second year in a row, Cherokee County School District has earned the highest honor in the State for providing fresh, healthy meals to students!</p> <p>CCSD's School Nutrition program, which serves five million meals each year in school cafeterias, won the Golden Radish Award at the Platinum Level from Georgia's Departments of Agriculture, Public Health, Education and Georgia Organics.</p> <p>The Platinum level is the highest recognition awarded to Georgia school nutrition programs for farm-to-school programs... from serving locally grown food in cafeterias to teaching students science through school gardens to demonstrating how to cook healthy meals. This is CCSD's third year in the competition, winning Platinum last year, as well.</p> <p>CCSD School Nutrition Director Tina Farmer will accept the award at a ceremony in October in Atlanta.</p>
