Summary Explanation and Background
<p>The Duke University Talent Identification Program (TIP) has completed its annual Talent Search for eligible 7th grade students. Duke supports academically talented students who have previously scored at or above the 95th percentile on a standardized test (i.e., Iowa, CogAT, Milestones) by providing them with the opportunity to take the Scholastic Assessment Test (SAT) and ACT, which are designed for above average eleventh and twelfth grade students. Districtwide procedures are utilized to build awareness and encourage increased student participation in TIP. One hundred and eighteen Cherokee County School District students participated with one student earning Grand and State Level honors and six students earning State Level honors for the Summer 2017-18SY and two students earning Grand and State Level honors and thirty-two students for the State Level honors for 2018-19SY.</p> <p>Recognition is presented to qualifying students in sixteen states whose scores meet Duke University's regional recognition criteria. Grand and State honorees will receive special Georgia Recognition at a Duke University Recognition Ceremony. Duke University now offers testing sessions in the summer months which constituted the change in CCSD recognition dates from May to August.</p>
