MINUTES OF REGULAR BOARD MEETING

7:00 p.m.

The Cherokee County Board of Education called its regular meeting to order at 7:02 p.m. on Thursday, June 18, 2020 in the Dr. Frank R. Petruzielo Educational Services Facility, 1205 Bluffs Parkway, Canton, Georgia. The meeting was conducted online/virtually and available to the public via live Internet streaming. Present were: School Board Chair Kyla Cromer; Vice-Chair Kelly Poole; Members Mike Chapman, John Harmon, Patsy Jordan, Clark Menard and Robert Rechsteiner; Superintendent Dr. Brian V. Hightower; and, Attorney Darrell Caudill.

Call to Order The call to order by Kyla Cromer was followed by the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America led by School Board Member Kelly Poole.

A brief inspiration was shared by Clark Menard.

Approval of Agenda On a motion by Mike Chapman seconded by Kelly Poole and carried, the Board unanimously adopted the Superintendent's agenda (7-0 vote).

 - Emphasized the purpose of the Reopening of Schools Advisory committee which is to provide feedback on reopening needs
 - Summarized the ability for parents to provide their preferences for reopening, and the committee to provide feedback throughout the process
 - Shared the following about reopening of school planning:
 - parent comments both pro and con
 - CCSD's concerns, priorities and areas of responsibility
 - student/employee safety guidance received from the CDC and GA Dept of Education
 - GA Dept of Education guidance for instructional delivery models including a traditional model, A/B day (hybrid) or all virtual
 - Shared how the Office of Human Resources is tasked with maintaining a safe work environment for employees
 - Shared how CCSD staff is making additional modifications for employees who interact with the public
 - Shared steps to reopen beginning with GHSA's "Return to Play" for athletes, followed by CCSD's "Return to Work" for employees (in phases) and completed by CCSD's "Reopening of Schools" for students
- Thanked our School Board Members for their kind words regarding our teachers and stated how proud CCSD is of the job our teachers did during digital learning days
- Reminded Board Members about upcoming budget hearings in July
- Reminded Board Members that the General Assembly session will likely conclude next week, thus Final budget news coming soon
- Shared that the Leadership Symposium (virtual) planned for summer will include topics such as SEL, COVID-19 and digital learning

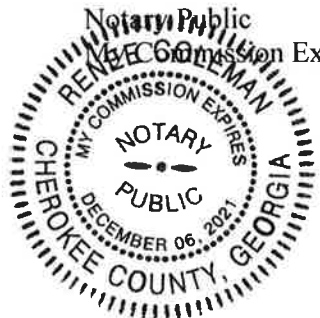
The members of the Board Of Education present for the executive session further certify and acknowledge that all discussions and proceeding conducted in executive session shall remain strictly confidential.
