VILLA is a free six-session parent academy program that offers CCSD parents the opportunity to learn more about their school district and how to be more engaged in our schools.

Participants will learn about the role of School Board members and school district operations, visit schools and district offices, participate in question-and-answer sessions with School Board members, the Superintendent and senior staff and attend a School Board meeting.

Sessions are 6:30 to 8:30 p.m. Tuesdays, Oct. 4, 11, 18 and 25 in Canton (with refreshments); with a field trip to schools from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. Tuesday, Nov. 1 (with lunch); and a final session and dinner from 4:30 to 7 p.m. Thursday, Nov. 17, with graduation at the 7 p.m. School Board meeting in Canton. Meals and other program costs are sponsored by Credit Union of Georgia, a CCSD Partner.
