Early Childhood Care & Education

Explore child care programs. Create effective learning environments for children. Learn safety and the various developmental stages. Upon completion of the pathway, all students earn adult and infant CPR certification and have the opportunity to earn college credit.

Food, Nutrition & Wellness

Learn the proper ways to cook delicious and nutritious meals. Participate in our cooking contests. Become ServSafe Certified for future employment. Upon completion of pathway, students have the opportunity to earn ServSafe certification.



Law Enforcement Services

Students will learn programming languages such as JavaScript and Python by creating apps, controlling robots, and writing their own programs.



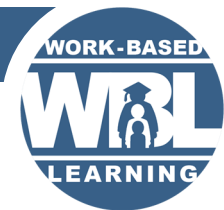
Engineering (STEM)
