2020-2021 Secondary School Report

The Cherokee County School District (CCSD) is a high-performing public school system in Metro Atlanta, with 42 schools and centers, 4,800 employees and approximately 42,200 students. CCSD is the ninth-largest school system in Georgia and is one of only 11 school districts in the nation to be named an Innovative District for 2018 by The International Center for Leadership in Education.

Woodstock High School is located in Woodstock, Georgia, approximately 35 miles north of Atlanta. WHS was established in 1996 and graduated its first class in 1999. The graduating class in 2020 had 546 students.

Woodstock High School offers the following athletic programs: baseball, basketball, cheerleading, cross country, fast pitch softball, football, golf, gymnastics, lacrosse, slow pitch softball, soccer, swimming, tennis, track and field, volleyball and wrestling.

WHS is on a traditional 7 period schedule. The school year is divided into two semesters (August-December and January-May). Students take six classes per semester and can earn .5 credit per class totaling three credits per semester; six credits per year. An additional .5 elective credit may be earned by participating in and completing the assignments during Teachers as Advisors (TAA) that meets each Friday.

The school day is divided into seven fifty-five minute periods which meet five days per week. Hours are 8:15 to 3:15. The school year began on August 3, 2020 and ends on May 28, 2021. First semester began on August 3, 2020; second semester on January 4, 2021.

WHS currently offers students the Georgia Department of Education International Skills Diploma Seal, the Georgia Seal of Biliteracy, nine different career pathway seals, and the Fine Arts Diploma Seal.

All transcripts reflect the grade earned *before* any quality points are added.

Class rank is determined by the weighted cumulative numeric grade average (NGA) of graduating seniors at the completion of their graduation requirements.

These averages are placed in numerical order from highest to lowest to determine class rank. All classes are included when calculating NGA and class rank.
