



Career Fair



Career Fair is a wonderful opportunity we present to the children at Arnold Mill so they can explore the world of work through hands-on, visual presentations by workers in our community. This allows the children to think about career choices at a young age. The students learn from this exploration and develop educational and occupational goals and values. We also stress that there are personal qualities (i.e. dependability, punctuality, getting along with others) that are needed to both get and keep jobs.

Our Kindergarten through 2nd grade students are visited in their classrooms for 30 minute presentations by the workers in our community. For the 3rd through 6th grade students, our presenters set up tables in the gymnasium, representing over 30 occupations with diagrams, presentation boards, models, pictures, and other means of visual presentation. The children are encouraged to ask questions in order to find out more about these different careers.
