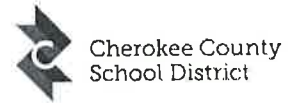

# Sequoyah High School Graduation Practice and Ceremony Guidelines

Dear Senior:

Graduation from high school is an event that comes only once in a lifetime. Your parents, relatives, friends, and, most importantly, you deserve a graduation ceremony that will be dignified and memorable. Your cooperation is essential. The following guidelines explain what is expected of you!

Not permitted are shorts, jeans, t-shirts, flip flops, tennis shoes, extremely informal attire inappropriate for the occasion, or any decoration or deviation from the traditional cap and gown, which would draw undue attention to the individual. The administration in charge has the final decision in denying a graduate's participation due to inappropriate attire. Please don't embarrass yourself, your family, and your school.

It is unnecessary to itemize the kinds of negative behavior unacceptable at the graduation ceremony. Any behavior which draws attention to you as an individual or detracts from the dignity of the ceremony itself will result in your exclusion from the ceremony.

We want your graduation to be special; we want it to have "class." Please do your part to make this graduation the best ever at Sequoyah.

**THE FOLLOWING GUIDELINES HAVE BEEN DEVELOPED BY BOTH FACULTY AND STUDENTS:**

- 1. SENIORS PARTICIPATING IN THE CEREMONY MUST BE PRESENT AT ALL GRADUATION PRACTICES. IF YOU ARE NOT AT PRACTICE, YOU WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO MARCH AT GRADUATION.** Students graduating first semester or from night school must make arrangements to attend the practices. **YOU ARE NOT TO BRING FOOD OR DRINK TO GRADUATION PRACTICE!** You must follow the county dress code for all practices.
2. Immediately following graduation, seniors will report to their homeroom teacher to receive their diploma. You will then be free to begin to celebrate your graduation!
3. Cooperation with members of the faculty in charge of practice is essential. Any breaking of school rules during practice will result in student's being taken out of the line-up and not participating in the graduation ceremony.
4. Seniors should report for graduation at **11:30 a.m. on Saturday, May 26<sup>th</sup>**. Report immediately to the area besides the Magnolia Room for lineup. Students are to carry caps/gowns to graduation. They are not to be on a hanger. You will put them on prior to lineup. No items, except for the cap/gown are to be brought to the graduation ceremony by the graduate. These include but are not limited to: cell phones, purses, cigarette lighters, book bags, gum, etc. **YOU WILL BE ASKED TO EMPTY YOUR POCKETS BEFORE YOU LINEUP, SO DO NOT BRING THESE ITEMS, OR WE WILL HAVE TO CONFISCATE THEM UNTIL AFTER THE CEREMONY. WE ARE NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY LOST ITEMS. DON'T BRING THEM!**
5. All students should be shown respect during the ceremony. Everyone is asked to refrain from excessive movement and unnecessary noise.
6. All spectators are required to dress in an appropriate manner, nice dress clothes.
7. Senior males should wear dark pants, white shirt, black dress shoes, and dark socks. Senior females should wear dark dress (if the dress does not show below the gown, any color will be OK) and black dress shoes, low heels are recommended.
8. **Graduation caps are not thrown in the air inside the facility.** After the Recessional, everyone will go out in front and caps will be thrown at that time.
9. Spectators will not be allowed to move up front or into aisles to take pictures of their graduates. (While you are standing there waiting for your graduate, you are blocking someone's view of their graduate.)
10. Any student apprehended for misbehavior will be removed from the ceremony and a record of the incident will be recorded on his/her permanent record. It's unfortunate when this is necessary, but it has been done before, and it will be done again if it is necessary.
11. At the discretion of the administration, the graduation ceremony may be stopped at any time.
- 12. Seniors must complete all course work (make-up tests, finals, etc.) by Wednesday, May 16<sup>th</sup> and satisfy graduation requirements by this time in order to participate in the graduation ceremony.**
- 13. Seniors must clear all outstanding debts by Wednesday, May 16<sup>th</sup> at 3:15 p.m. in order to participate in the graduation ceremony.**

# Final Transcripts

To send your Final Transcript to the college of your choice you will use GA Futures or Parchment. Set up your free account with both. You will be able to send your final transcript to any college in Georgia through GAcollge411 for free. You can go to Sequoyah's website and click on the Request Transcript button. Set up your free Parchment account and send your transcript anywhere in state or out of state for a \$5.00 fee. Both links are listed below.

All final transcripts will be uploaded to both GA Futures and Parchment by the end of June, if there are no complications. As soon as they are uploaded, an email will be sent to all graduates. **DO NOT ATTEMPT TO SEND A FINAL TRANSCRIPT UNTIL AFTER YOU HAVE RECEIVED THIS EMAIL.** If you do not wait, you will only be sending transcripts that were uploaded in January.
