| Feb. – March 24 | Students complete scholarship application and reference forms. |
| Feb. – March 24 | Applications matched with appropriate reference forms. If an application is missing one or more reference forms, the student is called and provided an opportunity to contact the reference(s). |
| March 24, 2017 | <u>Application deadline!</u> Committee meeting to review applications and select the recipient. |
| April 13, 2017 | Winner will be notified on or before this date. |
| April 20, 2017 | Winner will be recognized at the scheduled Cherokee County School Board Meeting. |
| May 30, 2017 | On or before this date a check will be sent to the student from the Cherokee County School District. |
